



Annual National Conference & Exhibition and Sport-Specific Training Conference

The NSCA Conference Committee invites the submission of presentations for the NSCA Annual National Conference and the Sport-Specific Training Conference. If you have an interest in presenting, please submit an application using the following guidelines. Speakers will not be accepted without the following:

Application Materials (materials will not be returned)

1. Letter of interest indicating the session type/length of presentation you are requesting (see below) and NSCA Member Number. NSCA Membership is preferred, but not required.
2. A presentation outline, including introduction, body, conclusion, and references.
3. A listing of conferences, symposia, and/or seminars at which you have presented.
4. Current resume not vitae (2 page maximum).

Session Types/Length

1. *From the Field*—20 minute presentation allowing 15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for questions. Presentation must be narrow in focus and practical.
2. Main Session #1—50 minutes
3. Main Session #2—1 hour and 50 minutes
4. Pre-conference symposium —4 or 6 hours

Speaker Qualification Criteria

1. Main Session(s)—Must hold a post-graduate degree (master's or higher) and/or be a CSCS® or NSCA-CPT with a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree.
2. *From the Field*—Must be a CSCS®, a NSCA-CPT®, or hold a 4-year degree (or higher).

Speaker Compensation

The compensation package provided to main sessions 50 minutes or longer is based upon the length of the session. Compensation is per session, not per person and includes an honorarium, one-night's lodging, airfare up to \$350, and conference registration. *From the Field*, Roundtable Discussions, Research Free Communication, and Poster presentations are not compensated.

NSCA Symposia and Clinics

The NSCA Education Department invites the submission of applications to present at NSCA Symposia and clinics.

Application Materials

1. Current resume or Curriculum Vitae.
2. Cover letter stating the clinic or symposium in which you are interested.

Session Types/Length

1. Vary by course, specific topic, hands-on, or lecture series.
2. Presenters must commit to all days (usually 2) of the course.

Speaker Qualifications

1. Must be NSCA member.
2. Must be NSCA certified.

Speaker Compensation

The NSCA will provide lodging, honorarium, and travel allowance. The amounts are determined by the NSCA based on individual speaking times and the clinic location.

Research Free Communications and Poster Applications

If you are a current NSCA member, you may submit an abstract. The NSCA Research Committee will evaluate all submitted abstracts. Accepted submissions may be presented as a 10-minute oral presentation or poster presentation at the NSCA National Conference. **Do not submit an abstract if your attendance at conference is questionable.**

Oral abstracts and poster presentations are due by **March 1** of each year.

Research Free Communications and Poster applicants must complete the abstract submission form on the NSCA website (www.nasca-lift.org/abstracts).

Submit application materials for all presentations, except *Research Free Communications and Poster Applications*, by May 15 of the prior year. Applicants will be notified of selection by October 15.
