Certification News & Updates

Kudos to all that became recertified!

Congratulations to everyone that has met the continuing education unit (CEU) requirements needed to maintain the Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist® (CSCS®) certification and/or the NSCA-Certified Personal Trainer® (NSCA-CPT®) certification.

By completing the CEU requirements, certificants have demonstrated that they are staying abreast of evolving current information and keeping knowledge and skills in the profession fresh. These standards help uphold the NSCA Certification's nationally accredited status.

Failure to Report CEUs

The deadline for submitting an appeal is June 30, 2012

If you did not earn and officially submit your CEUs for the 2009 – 2011 Recertification Period your NSCA certification has been revoked.

If you were unable to report your CEUs for extenuating circumstances you can appeal the revocation by completing the Appeals Form <http://www.nasca-lift.org/nscapdf/download/NSCA%20CERTIFICATION%20APPEALS%20FORM%202011.pdf>.

Updates to the NSCA Website

Tentatively set for late spring 2012, the NSCA is merging the certification and membership websites. This will allow for easier navigation and improved CEU reporting. The current NSCA Certification website (nsca-cc.org) will no longer be available after February 1, 2012. CEU reporting will not be available until the new unified website has been launched. The NSCA apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause. The next recertification deadline is December 31, 2014.

2014 Recertification — Create a Plan!

Abraham Lincoln once said, "If I had eight hours to chop down a tree, I'd spend six sharpening my axe." You have 3 years to accrue the equivalent of 60 hours of continuing education (6.0 CEUs). Maintaining your certification and earning CEUs is easy when you create and then follow a plan. Here are some easy CEU-garnering opportunities:

1. Attend an NSCA event or state clinic — CEUs range from 0.4 – 2.0 for a given event. Not only can you enhance your knowledge and improve your craft, but these events are wonderful opportunities to network and meet other certified professionals in the field.
2. First Aid and CPR — maintaining these certifications earns you 0.5 CEUs each.
3. Volunteer to present at a clinic, conference, or symposium — not only do you earn 1.0 CEU per hour of presentation (for topics that fall under the scope of your certification) but presenting on relevant topics is an excellent way to really understand a topic while enhancing your standing as a professional in the field.
4. Get involved — serve on an NSCA committee or write a published article for 0.5 – 1.5 CEUs.
5. Expand your knowledge base — you earn 0.5 CEUs per year for personal development, which includes anything you do that enhances your fitness/strength and conditioning knowledge. This includes reading journals, magazines, visiting relevant websites, etc.

Grants and Scholarships

Deadline: March 15, 2012



The NSCA financially supports the higher education of students pursuing a career in the strength and conditioning field and facilitates dissemination of strength and conditioning research. The NSCA is accepting applications for the following grants and scholarships:

GNC® Nutritional Research Grant:

GNC® sponsors this nutrition-based research grant. The purpose of the project must fall within the mission of the NSCA. One \$2,500 grant will be awarded.

Graduate Research Grant:

Master's and Doctoral – This grant program funds graduate research in strength and conditioning that is consistent with the mission of the NSCA. Master's Student Research Grant proposals are not to exceed \$5,000. Doctoral Student Research Grant proposals are not to exceed \$10,000.

International Collaboration Grant:

The NSCA International Collaboration Grant has been established to solicit creative proposals to facilitate collaboration among an American-based colleague and an international colleague. Applicants can apply to visit one or multiple international colleagues or propose hosting one or multiple international colleagues in support of the proposed project. A total of \$50,000 will be made available from this program each year with no predetermined limit on the number of awards to be made annually.

Senior Investigator Grant:

This grant program funds full-time faculty members in a senior faculty position at the rank of Associate Professor or higher. The purpose and specific aims of the research project must be consistent with the Mission of the NSCA. Awards in the amount of \$25,000 will be given as part of this program.

Young Investigator Grant:

This grant program funds individuals employed by nonprofit research organizations who are within seven (7) years from conferral of their Doctorate degree. The maximum award is \$15,000 and the purpose of the research project must be consistent with the mission of the NSCA.

Challenge Scholarship:

The Challenge Scholarship is given to NSCA Members seeking either an undergraduate or graduate degree in a strength and conditioning-related field. Awards in the amount of \$1,500 are granted.

High School Scholarship:

This program provides funding to high school seniors preparing to enter college. \$1,500 awards are available.

Minority Scholarship:

This scholarship is designed to encourage minorities to enter into the field of strength and conditioning. Awards of \$1,500 are available.

Power Systems® Professional Scholarship:

This scholarship is sponsored by Power Systems® to assist members in pursuit of a career as a strength and conditioning coach. One \$1,500 award will be granted.

Women's Scholarship:

This scholarship is designed to encourage women to enter into the field of strength and conditioning. Awards of \$1,500 are available.

Call for 2012 National Conference Abstracts

The deadline for abstract submission is March 1, 2012.

The NSCA is now accepting abstract submissions for their 2012 National Conference, held July 11 – 14 in Providence, Rhode Island. All abstracts selected for presentation at the conference will be published in an online supplement to the Journal of Strength and Conditioning Research.

Abstracts can be submitted for either poster or podium presentation. Only two abstracts may be submitted per lead author. Of those two, only one may be submitted as a podium presentation (as the number of time slots for these is limited). Graduate and doctoral students may submit only one abstract for award consideration.
